

**TPWD Lamar County
Prairiland Trail Reno to Blossom
Project ID: RT1112**



The Lamar County Prairiland Trail is a 3.5-mile pedestrian/bicycle trail that connects the 6.5-mile in use Trail de Paris and the Reno Rail Trail to the City of Blossom.

An environmental study was required to obtain clearance for the area.

A geotechnical investigation was needed to investigate soil conditions and make bridge abutment recommendations. Bridge abutments were designed by a structural engineer. Civil engineering was required for the trail design and bridge approaches.

The trail itself consisted of 29,983 SY of cement stabilized subbase and 458 TN of cement material. Lamar County installed an all weather oil sand aggregate type surface. Lamar County also maintained compliance with the Army Corps of Engineers Nationwide Permit 14 & the construction stormwater pollution prevention plan, silt fencing, and regrassing.
