Hayter Engineering assisted the District in obtaining funding for this project through the Texas Water Development Board Drinking Water State Revolving Fund. This project was part of a larger project which included System 7 waterline improvement from Toco to Roxton which were completed in 2012.

Improvements in this project included the installation of a solar powered mixer to eliminate the need for electricity from a utility company to significantly reduce life-cycle cost of the mixers. New tank inlet piping and separate inlet and outlet piping was installed for each tank and connected to the system piping.
