Improvements included:

- 6,974 square yards of cement stabilized subbase
- 6,336 square yards of 2" HMAC multi-use trail wearing surface
- 2,094 linear feet of concrete sidewalk/shared use path
- 3,000 linear feet of bike lanes
- 219 square yards of concrete driveway replacement
- curb ramps, signage, striping, regrassing
