This project addressed the rehabilitation of dilapidated curbs and sidewalks for public safety during annual tourist events providing access to businesses and to historical and recreational points of interest for the City of Cooper's Heritage Square.

Improvements on all four sides of the Square included 2,050 SF of preparation of right-of-way, 13,304 SF of sidewalk reconstruction, 1,269 LF of curb and gutter, 944 SF of sidewalk corner reconstruction and one handicapped ramp which included landing and handrails.

Services provided by Hayter Engineering are listed at right.

This project was financed by the Texas Department of Transportation and it was completed in 2003.
