This project was financed by the Texas Water Development Board Small Community Hardship Project fund.

The project included the demolition of an existing 100,000 gallon elevated tank, the erection of a new 150,000 gallon 4-legged elevated tank, the rehabilitation of the existing 250,000 gallon west elevated storage tank, and the relocation of an 8" water line.

Improvements for the west elevated tank included: interior sandblasting and painting, and exterior painting; surface preparation; testing; clean-up and disposal of waste products; logo painting; a new ladder safety climbing system; a new level sensor line; and miscellaneous electrical work.

This project was completed in 2007.
