

## Sidewalks for Downtown Pocket Park Commerce, Texas



A pocket park was developed in the downtown business district where several buildings have been removed directly across from City Hall along Alamo Street. Hayter Engineering performed the sidewalk, handicap ramp, and stairs improvements for this project.

Improvements included the removal of 2,593 LF of sidewalk; installation of 2,381 LF of new sidewalk; removal and replacement of two retaining walls; and a new handicap ramp. The existing sidewalks were in very poor condition and handicap accessibility was not available.

This project was key to the development of the new pocket park providing citizens safe and convenient access.

Services provided by Hayter Engineering are listed at right.

This project was constructed within schedule and budget in 2012.

Alamo Street constructed of brick pavers, that can be seen in two of the photographs was another Hayter Engineering project completed prior to this pocket park project.
